LINHAY, COMPTON/MARLDON) NOTICE 2020**

**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC & PARKING**

**DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL** hereby give **NOTICE** that:

From **MONDAY 5 OCTOBER 2020**  
for a maximum of 5 days

Until **FRIDAY 9 OCTOBER 2020** (both dates inclusive)

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed or wait on the sections of Affected Roads.

Roads affected -

**COMPTON TO HULSTERCOMBE LINHAY, COMPTON/MARLDON**

The alternative, signed, route for vehicles will be via - THE ROUTE FROM TOTNES SHOULD TAKE THE A385 ALL THE WAY TO THE TWEENAWAY LIGHTS JUNCTION IN TORBAY, (NOT GO THROUGH BERRY POMEROY) – AT TWEENAWAY THE TRAFFIC SHOULD BE DIRECTED LEFT ALONG KINGS ASH ROAD AND BACK INTO MARLDON ALONG CHURSCOMBE ROAD.

This temporary restriction is considered necessary to enable -

**CCTV WITH FLOW CONTROL OF MAINLINE TO IDENTIFY SOURCES OF INFILTRATION**

**THE CLOSURE WILL BE WITHIN THE HOURS OF 07:30 - TO 17:00 IT WILL BE LIFTED PER EVENING AND REPLOYED EACH DAY**
